7. Training for all counselors will be from **9:00am-1:00pm on Saturday, July 10<sup>th</sup>**. We will meet in the sanctuary. Lunch will be provided.

8. Daycamp will be held **Monday-Friday, from 2:00- 5:30, July 12-16, 2010**. Counselors will be required to arrive no later than **1:30pm** for staff meetings, and will often have to stay later than **5:30pm** in order to clean up, etc. The Event Finale will be from **7:00-8:00pm on July 16** and the Children's Worship Service will be Sunday, **July 18 at 10:30am**. Do you know of any scheduling conflicts you will have with any of these dates or times?

9. Daycamp counseling can be a lot of fun, but the main goal needs to be ministry to the children in the camp. It will be a rewarding experience, if approached with patience, commitment, and responsibility. Counselors are teachers, guides, and friends. They will be responsible for 10-15 children, to ensure they have a safe, fun, and meaningful camp experience. This requires a genuine and thoughtful commitment on the part of the counselors.
